EdenParks the *next* generation glasshouses

The Royal Horticultural Society (RHS) focuses on providing information, education and research in the field of gardening. RHS chose to realise this project because of their 200-year anniversary. 'The Glasshouse' stands in one of the gardens of the RHS organisation near London, and was officially opened by Queen Elisabeth in 2007. In this botanical glasshouse flowers, plants and trees from around the world are brought together. This beautiful curved glasshouse, type HighLight, reaches a height of 12.5 metres. There are three climatic zones, a moist, a dry and a tropical climate (high temperature and high humidity).

In the tropical zone the RHS organizes an annual butterfly show, which is very impressive as shown by the many visitors. The technical rooms, classrooms and the cultivation areas are located in 2,200 m² traditional Venlo greenhouses next to 'The Glasshouse'. The RHS uses this greenhouse for education and plant research.
